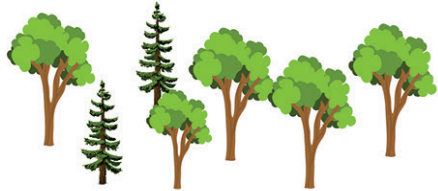
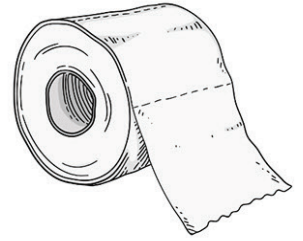


Focus on Recycled Toilet Paper

Rest assured, this is not about recycling toilet paper! It is about toilet paper made by recycling waste paper and cardboard.



Each person in the UK is estimated to use 7 miles of toilet paper per year. This would be a trail of toilet paper the entire length of the no. 1 bus route from Wigginton to Chapelfields.



Our estimated individual lifetime usage of toilet paper in the UK requires 7 trees to be felled

15% of global deforestation is estimated as being due to toilet paper production. This contributes to global warming, reduces habitats for birds and wildlife, increases soil erosion and flooding



The number of trees felled simply to be flushed down the toilet can be reduced by using **Recycled** instead of Traditional toilet paper..

The Tear Fund Toilet Twinning programme helps the poorest communities overseas to have sustainable access to decent toilets, safe drinking water and healthy hygiene. Toilet Twinning funds hygiene education via community-led workshops, sourcing local materials for families and communities to build their own toilets.
