#### St Nicholas' Church, Wigginton Building and Fabric Fund Appeal

Every five years an inspection has to be carried out on every Church of England church building – a 'Quinquennial Inspection'. St Nicholas' Church building was inspected in 2024 and a schedule of remedial works was drawn up, principally involving repairs to the **church roof, bell tower, church bells, masonry, guttering and drainage.** It is estimated that this will cost at least £10,000 but, of course, there are always ongoing maintenance costs for the Church, Hall, Churchyard and Garden of Rest.

St Nicholas' Parochial Church Council is launching an appeal to establish a long-term Restricted Fund to help pay for the maintenance of, or undertake new work or improvements on, the Church and Hall Building and Fabric, the Churchyard and Garden of Rest. If, in due course, there is any surplus on this fund, it will be used for the PCC's general purposes.

The aim is to raise an initial £10,000. Can you help? Your contribution will be greatly appreciated. A huge 'thank you' to those who have already responded to this appeal with generous donations.




